To be eligible to enrol in the Higher Level Skills initiative, prospective students must:

- be aged 15 years or above and no longer at school
- permanently reside in Queensland
- be an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident (includes humanitarian entrant), temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen
- not have or be enrolled in a certificate IV or higher-level qualification, not including qualifications completed at school and foundations skills training
- Show proof they have been employed on a continuous basis for at least 1 month.
