## SIT30713 Certificate III in Hospitality

Using the Queensland State Government's Certificate 3 Guarantee initiative

To be eligible to enrol in the Certificate 3 Guarantee, prospective students must:

- be aged 15 years or above and no longer at school (with the exception of VET in School (VETIS) students — see the [VETIS fact sheet](#) for more information)
- permanently reside in Queensland
- be an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident (includes humanitarian entrant), temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen
- Do not hold, and not be enrolled in, a certificate III or higher-level qualification, not including qualifications completed at school and foundation skills training. We will assess your eligibility for Government subsidy Nationally Recognised Qualifications. Please note that by completing this certificate you will no longer be eligible for a subsidized training place under the Certificate 3 Guarantee.
